- 2. no 'offensive registration' in Nominet
- 3. 12 month period in 'co.za' (as opposed to 24 in Nominet) for the rebuttable presumption provision to apply
- 4. differing 'rights' definitions. No reference to descriptive names in the '.co.za' definition
- 5. compare Nominet's 3(a)(i)A and '.co.za"s 4(1)(a)(i)
- 6. '.co.za' has adopted the old Nominet provision in relation to gripe/fan sites
- 7. the differing consequences of a finding of Reverse Domain Name Hijacking
- 8. in '.co.za' adjudicators are encouraged to take into account foreign decisions
